Planned electricity supply upgrade in your area

Low-voltage underground CONSAC Cable Replacement Project

Dear Resident/Business owner,

As part of Ausgrid's capital works program, Ausgrid previously replaced the existing low-voltage underground cables in your area. As part of these works, Ausgrid is planning to commission these new cables, so that they can begin supplying electricity to the local homes and businesses in the area.

To allow us to carry out our work, we will need to excavate small holes along the footpath to expose the new cables. See overleaf for a map that outlines the areas this work will occur.

Work is **planned to start on Wednesday 8 March 2023 and will be conducted periodically until late July 2023**, weather and ground conditions permitting. At least four business days to works commencing for each stage, a targeted notifications of work detailing times and dates will be distributed to residents.

How the work may affect you

There will be some noise generated during the work, however, we will endeavour to keep this to a minimum.

There will be an increase in truck and vehicle movements in and around the worksite, with a variety of different machines being used as part of this work.

To ensure the safety of the community, we will place steel plates over the open trenches when work is not taking place.

There will be temporary changes to traffic where we are working. We will use traffic controllers to guide drivers and pedestrians around the work area.

There will also be temporary parking restrictions in place so that we can carry out our work safely. We will start reserving parking spaces in the area with signage prior to our work.

As part of this work, power outage will take place. The **customers directly impacted by power outages will receive an outage notification letter** four (4) clear business days prior, confirming the outage details.

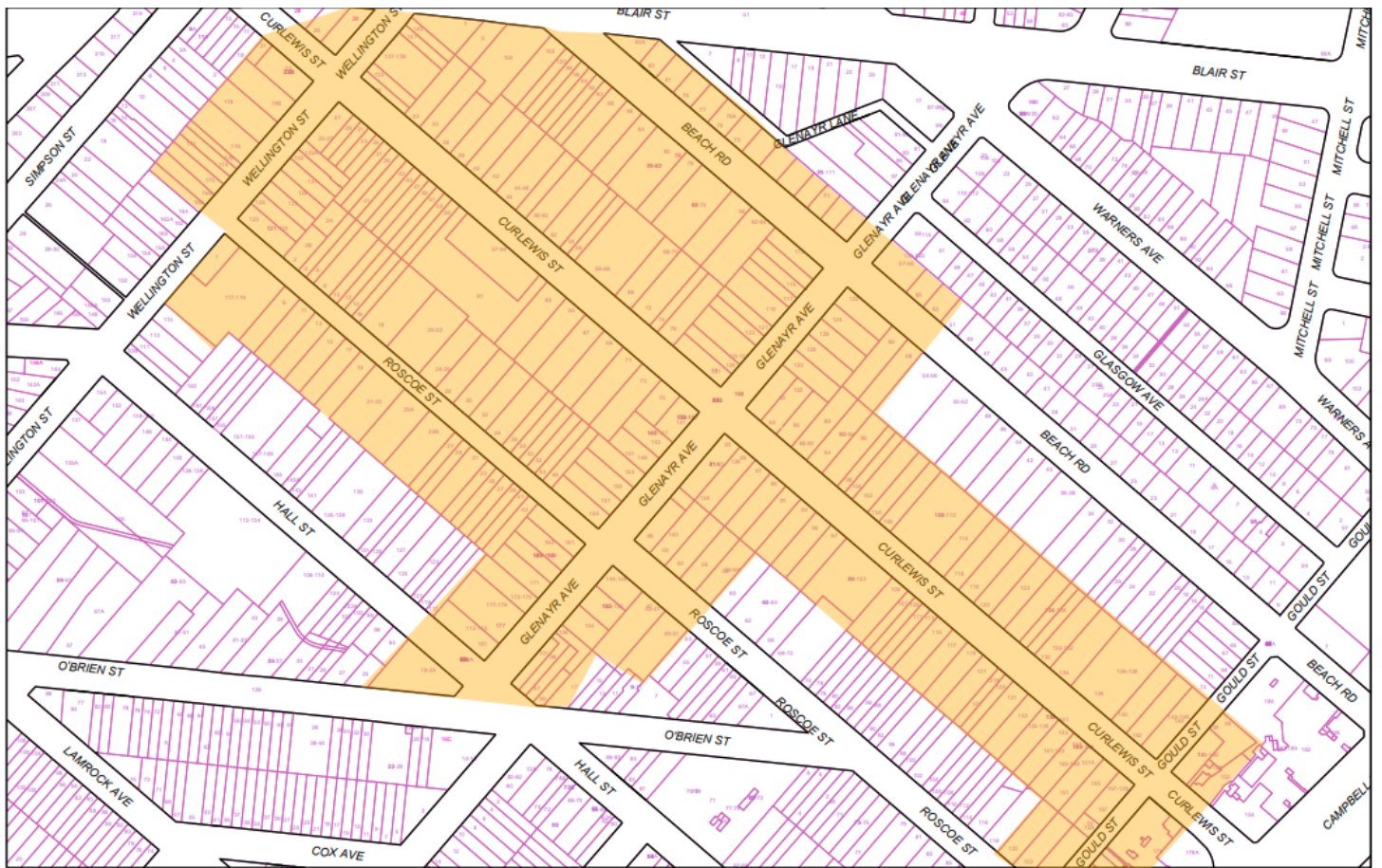
