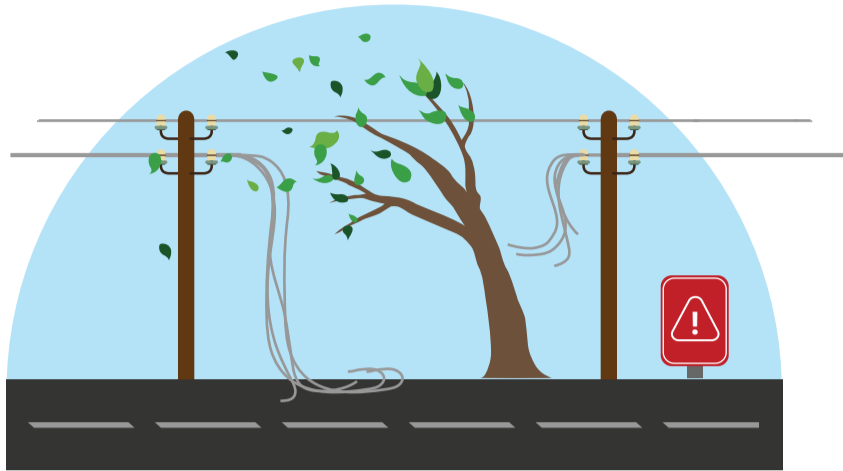


Be prepared for a storm

To stay safe, it is important to be prepared.



TIP 1

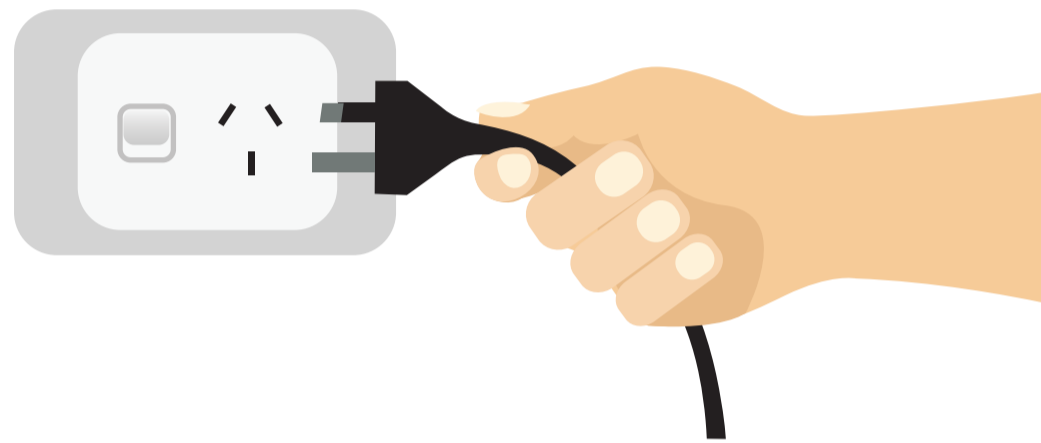
Be careful outside

Always assume fallen powerlines are live. Stay at least 8 metres away and call Ausgrid immediately on **13 13 88** to report.

TIP 2

Unplug sensitive devices

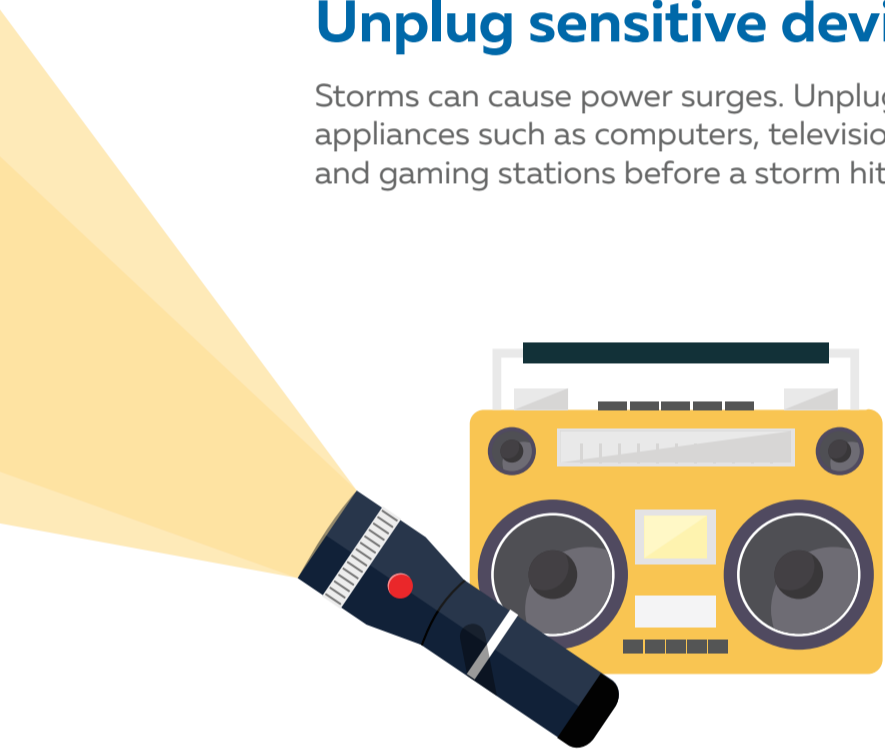
Storms can cause power surges. Unplug sensitive appliances such as computers, televisions, smart devices and gaming stations before a storm hits.



TIP 3

Keep a torch and radio handy

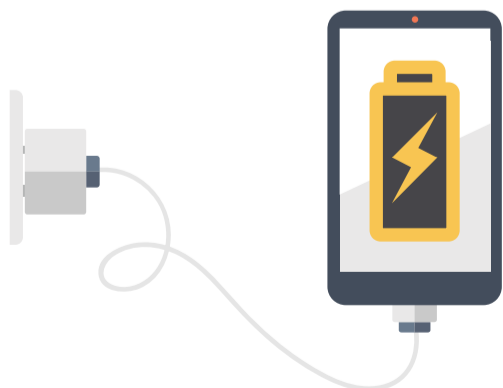
Check your torch is working and keep spare batteries. Portable radios are helpful for weather and power updates. If you need to use candles, keep away from children and extinguish before sleeping.



TIP 4

Tidy up and clear a path

Pack away loose items left outside and clear a path to your electrical switchboard and garage door.



TIP 5

Charge mobile phones before a storm

Charge your mobile phone, portable battery chargers and other devices before a storm hits.
